Proposed Standing Rules

Section 8 GFWC/KFWC Funds

Funds will be identified in two categories: General Fund and Charitable Fund; Information on the Income and Expenses will be categorized and identified under their respective categories.

General Fund Income: **Art; Dues; Headquarter Operation** – 1228 Society, Club Donations Rent (upstairs apartment); **Interest** – Interest from Investment/Endowment, Interest from Student Loans; **Kentucky Clubwoman** – Business Ads, Club Ads, Individual Subscriptions, Media Fees; **Marketplace** – Merchandise Sold, (inc. cookbooks). Yearbooks Sales; **State Convention** – Meals, Registration; **Other** – Kentucky First Ladies’ Project, Unbudgeted Activity
Juniors Income – GFWC Jr. Project Fund Donations, Junior Club Donations, Junior Travel (Funds Raised), KFWC Jr. Project Fund Donations, KFWC Outstanding Junior Club.

General Fund Expenses: **Board Expenses** – President’s Desk, President’s Travel, Junior Director Expense, Junior Director Travel, President/Jr.-elect Orientation, Treasurer’s Expense, Travel (other members); **DUES** – GFWC, SER; **Headquarters** – Insurance, Maintenance of Building & Grounds, Office Equipment, Security Alarm, Supplies, Taxes, Telephone, Internet Technology, Utilities **Kentucky Clubwoman** – Mailing, Postage, Printing, Production, Website; **Office Operation** – Office Supplies, Postage, Mailing Service, Printing; Payroll Taxes, Salaries, Unemployment Insurance, Workman’s Compensation; **Marketplace** – GFWC Purchases, Other Vendors; **Other** – Gaming License, Kentucky First Ladies Project, Unbudgeted Activity, Yearbook.

Charitable Fund INCOME: Dollars for Delegates, KET, Ky. Women’s History and Resources, Leadership/Membership Development, President’s Special Projects, Student Scholarship Donations. Veterans: District 1-6-9; District 2-3-4, Districts 5-7-8; Director of Junior Clubs Special Project

Charitable Fund EXPENSE: KET, Ky. Women’s History and Resources, Leadership & Development, President’s Special Project, Student Scholarships Awarded, Veterans Expense, Director of Junior Clubs Special Project.
